CHEVALIER, IN HIS TIME...

His life: In the seminary in Bourges, Jules had befriended a few of his fellow students, Emile Maugenest and Charles Piperon among others. He was convinced that a fervent group, well trained and possessing a solid spirituality, would be capable of "fighting the egoism and indifference" which outraged Christ's heart. (Rules 1857; Meditations for each day of the year, according to the Spirit of The Sacred Heart, vol.1)

His words:

Even though it consists of different members, humanity nevertheless is made up of the same blood and forms but one body, the same body. The Heart that gives life to all the members of this body is the Heart of Jesus. Only this Heart unites us with God. As soon as we break away from one another, we lose, together with the divine life of which Jesus is the source, the true feeling of human kinship...That divine Heart is thus the centre around which gravitates all other hearts (Article in The Messenger of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, vol. 7, June 1865; p. 529).

CHEVALIER, FOR TODAY...

"To show the Heart of God" to all people, that is indeed what Jesus, the Word Incarnate, did throughout his public life...Chevalier says: "...Everywhere, He displays an unfailing gentleness, a compassionate tenderness, capable of touching the most hardened hearts; He does not drive away anyone; the little ones, the powerful ones, the poor, the sinners, all gather around Him..." Jesus came to show us God's love, a marvelous and transforming love'; to empower us to believe that God is a loving God (Fifteen Days Prayer with Jules Chevalier, p.20).
